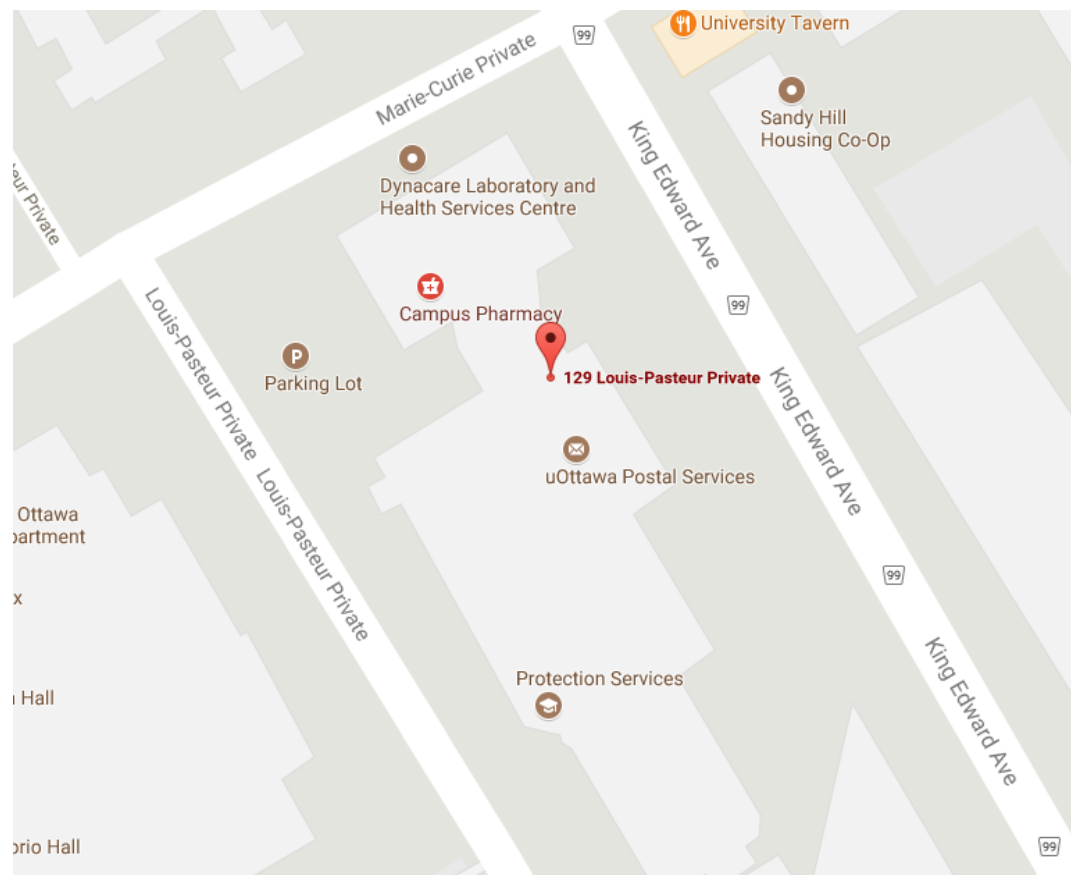

Note: Louis Pasteur is the building directly behind the University Health Services, see map below:

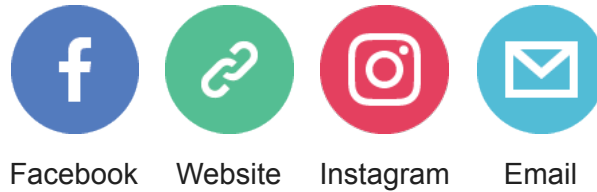


Fewer emails, more news!



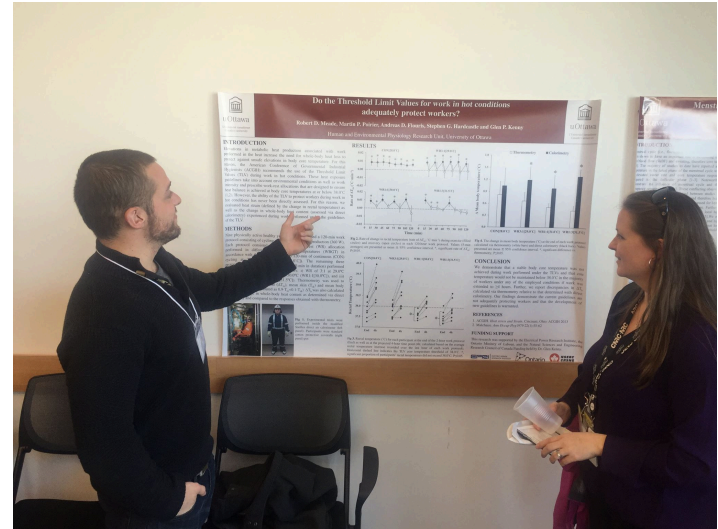
